DRESSING ROOMS & HOSPITALITY

- · 2 rooms are needed.
- Dressing rooms should be furnished with chairs, well-lit mirrors, and access to a bathroom dedicated exclusively for the band/artist.
- One common/green room should be available with water, coffee ((regular & Decaf)) & tea. Also the addition of light snacks (cheese, fruit, sandwiches, or similar) would be greatly appreciated.
- Dinner for 5 people (hot preferred). Food allergies include: PORK.
- If venue is unable to provide a dinner, a meal buyout can be negotiated between presenter and artist (typically \$20 to \$25 a person).
- Any form of sugary drink available, i.e. juice, soda, etc. ((artist is Type 1 Diabetic))
- · When possible 2 bottles of merlot or cabernet sauvignon.

MERCHANDISE (WHEN AGREED UPON)

- TWO 8' tables need to be available in the lobby.
- Black table cloth or skirting.
- We will bring someone to manage the sales, however the use of one or two additional persons are needed for assistance during intermission and after the concert.

HOTELS (WHEN REQUIRED)

- 5 non-smoking, double/king size rooms.
- · Hotels need to be within reasonable distance to the venue.
- · Runners should be available to transport band to and from hotel & venue.

MISCELLANEOUS

- · Please have 2 water bottles available in each musicians station.
- One stool on stage for Jaimee.

ADDITIONAL VENUE/PROMOTER EVENTS

The band and artist are generally available and willing to attend in post-concert events, such as
dinners, receptions, or other venue related gatherings. Please notify us in advance so that we can
adjust our travel schedule to accommodate you.
